In order to do so, they hoped to build a venue space on their property, just 200 yards from their existing home. Consequently, Purple Cherry Architects had just 10 months to perform the task of a lifetime. "I would just tell you, this is the biggest miracle I've pulled off in 34 years," says Cherry.
