## OXFORD RESIDENCE

Located on a tributary of the Chesapeake Bay, this classic Oxford, Maryland residence was designed to embrace spectacular 180-degree water views. Encompassing 8,000 square feet, it is just one room deep, curving around the land where it sits so that the living space on each of its two floors is rotated to the adjacent water's edge—ensuring a view of the water.

The home's extensive millwork adds a human scale to the incredible structure. The open kitchen layout and double islands create an inviting space for guests to gather. Soft blue and green color palettes enhance the coastal ambiance. Large windows and doors along the waterside provide abundant natural light and striking waterfront views. The waterside pool and terrace parallel the large porch and great room, creating a significant outdoor entertainment area on this magnificent site.
